All concerns must be brought to the Christian Brothers Safeguarding Coordinator (England), Safeguarding Lead or Deputy Lead. **Never delay taking action.** If you are unable to contact the Safeguarding Coordinator (England), Safeguarding Lead or Deputy Lead, you can contact the Catholic Safeguarding Standards Agency (CSSA) should you require advice.

Allegation of harm of a child or adult at risk
by a member of clergy / religious / church personnel comes to light, including:

- ❖ inappropriate behaviour
- ❖ possible harm caused to a child or adult at risk, or
- ❖ possible crime committed against a child or adult at risk
